The 2010 running of the Copper Basin 300 Sled Dog Race is fast approaching. This year's race will start on Saturday, January 9, 2010. **In and effort to keep the race competitive, and include local businesses, this year the race begins in front of KCAM radio station in downtown Glennallen, runs clockwise around the route, and ends at Tolsona Lake.** We would be delighted to add your name to the field of mushers!

The purse will be announced **only** on our website. Please check it frequently for updated information regarding the race. You may access it at [www.cb300.com](http://www.cb300.com)

The CB300 will once again be providing straw for your check points. You must pick up your straw at the food drop when you drop your bags. The fee for the straw is included in your entry.

Race registration will begin at the American Legion Hall in downtown Glennallen on Friday, January 8th at 10:00 AM and continue until 2:00 PM. The mushers meeting will start at 5:00 PM Friday, January 8th at: Brown Bear Rhodehouse. A Rookie meeting will follow. The Mushers Awards will be held on Tuesday, January 12th.

The food drop will once again be at Copper Valley Construction's yard in downtown Glennallen. Make sure all your drops are clearly marked with your name and destination checkpoint and securely packaged ready to deliver. You will be issued a food drop sheet which must be presented upon registration at the Legion Hall.

**Distances between checkpoints:**  
Mileage may vary due to trail and snow conditions.

Glennallen to Tolsona	24 miles
Tolsona to Wolverine (Lake Louise)	27 miles
Lake Louise to Sourdough	48 miles
Sourdough to Meier's Lake	40 miles
Meier's Lake to Paxson	32 miles
Paxson to Chistochina	60 miles
Chistochina to Glennallen	52 miles
Glennallen to Tolsona	24 miles

If you have any questions, the contact information is on the entry form. Please note that if you want a musher profile published on our website and documented during the race for your sponsors, you will need to provide us with a new profile. We will not automatically be using any old profiles or “borrowing” the information from any other race. This is to prevent the recycling of outdated and/or incorrect information.

We do have a “Sponsor Family” program. We have some really nice people that are willing to open their home to you. This is on a first come first serve basis and could help some mushers to offset some expenses of running the races, while letting the public get to know the musher and their families. If you are interested in this option please note it on your entry form and someone will contact you as to the availability of a home to stay in.
